

Player/Cheerleader Code of Conduct

Repeated violations of this code may result in disciplinary action against the player/cheerleader. The player's first offense will be resolved by the player's coach as a team disciplinary issue. The player's second offense may be resolved by the Player Agent in consultation with the Board of Directors. The third offense will be resolved by the Board of Directors and may result in removal from the team.

The following may be considered association disciplinary violations:

- Lying
- Cheating
- Stealing
- Use of profanity
- Poor sportsmanship
- Fighting
- Bullying
- Abuse of players safety equipment
- Disrespectful behavior (including crude, profane, or sexually suggestive comments or gestures)
- Suspension from school

The following actions by a player/cheerleader will result in immediate removal from the team:

- Use of alcohol, drugs, or tobacco
- Criminal acts
